What is Saddle Seat?

A Brief Overview of Saddle Seat Riding (prepared by the OEF Saddle Seat Committee)

Saddle Seat was developed as a style of riding "gaited" horses in order to show them off to their greatest advantage. "Gaited" horses include such breeds as American Saddlebreds, Tennessee Walking Horses, and Rocky or Kentucky Mountain Horses. Arabians and Morgans can also be ridden in the saddle seat style.

Saddle Seat riding and the breeds associated with it were, for the most part, developed in the United States by plantation farmers; the horses and method of riding them had to be comfortable enough to spend hours in the saddle overseeing plantations, but also showy enough to take to town. Over the years, Saddle Seat has evolved as the best way to compete with those breeds of horses as well as proving to be a comfortable way to ride at any time.

Saddle Seat saddles (often referred to as "Cutback" or "Lane Fox") have a cutback pommel to make room for the horses withers, and are placed so that the flap sits behind the shoulder and the seat is horizontal on the horse's back. Riders carry their hands higher than other styles of riding, in order to achieve the proper balance in accordance with the high head set desired in the show ring. Saddle Seat show horses may be specially shod by farriers to complement their brilliant movement.

Saddle Seat competition is divided into divisions which can be outlined by rider age, horse age and experience, the number of gaits performed (either three gaits or five) or such designations as Open or Pleasure. The different breeds have their own distinct divisions. Arabians can show as either Park, English Pleasure or Country English Pleasure. Morgans can show as Park, English Pleasure or Classic Pleasure. Saddlebreds can show as Five-Gaited, Three-Gaited, Show Pleasure or Country Pleasure. Tennessee Walkers can show as Plantation Pleasure or Performance.

Another division in which Saddle Seat breeds can compete is Saddle Seat Equitation. In these classes (divided according to rider age) the rider is judged and not the animal, however the horse should be suitable for the Saddle Seat Riding style. In these classes the riders are worked both ways of the ring (usually at a walk, trot and canter) and can then be asked to perform individual workouts. Only the top competitors are asked to perform individually. Those who are asked to do individual workouts are then judged 50% on their rail work and 50% on the workout.

Within each division, dependent upon the breed of horse, riders can be asked to show at a variety of gaits. Arabians and Morgans show at the walk, trot and canter. For Arabians, the trot can be broken down into Normal trot and Strong trot (which is faster and stronger than a Normal trot). Morgans can be asked to perform at the Trot or Park trot (which generally shows animation, collection and balance), and the Road trot, which shows balance and ground covering action with extreme speed to be penalized.

Saddlebreds can show at the walk, trot or Park trot (which has the same requirements as the Morgan division), and the Extended trot (which should be faster, stronger, bolder and show extension), as well, Saddlebred five gaited horses are required to perform the slow gait and the rack.

The Equine Canada rule book describes the slow gait as "developed from the pace to be a four beat gait with each of the four feet contacting the ground separately. In the takeoff, the lateral front and hind feet start almost together but the hind foot contacts the ground slightly before its lateral forefoot. The slow gait is highly collected gait with most of the propulsion coming from the hindquarters, while the forequarters assist in the pull of the final beats. The slow gait is not a medium rack."

One visit to www.netposse.com and you will realize that horse theft is more common that you may think. A way to help safeguard your horse from theft is to have them easily identifiable. There are three ways to help in the identification of your horse.

1) Freeze branding- Visual deterrent and cannot be altered. Horse cannot be sold or slaughtered without proper paperwork. CANNOT ALTER.

2) Tatoos- Kits can be sold by anyone - catalog to feed stores to ebay. Anyone can do tatoos and THEY CAN BE ALTERED.

3) Microchips- Not a visual deterrent and slaughter houses do not scan horses. Many micro chip companies out there and there is NOT a universal scanner so micro chips CAN be missed.

Picayune Strand State Forest

Picayune Strand State Forest is in the heart of an ecosystem called the Big Cypress Basin. The majority of this forest is under water during periods of considerable rainfall. The forest is comprised of cypress strands, wet prairie, and pine flatwoods in the lowlands and subtropical hardwood hammocks in the uplands. The northern section of the Belle Meade Tract contains many second growth South Florida slash pine, with some remnant trees being over 100 years old. The forest provides habitat for many species of wildlife making wildlife viewing a popular activity. The following species have been sighted in the forest: black bear, bald eagle, wood stork, Big Cypress fox squirrel and swallow-tailed kites. Although Florida panthers are rarely visible, they do leave tracks for the observant visitor. Female panthers have borne cubs in the state forest in recent years.

Picayune Strand State Forest offers many recreational opportunities. A 22 mile horse trail winds across the Belle Meade Tract from Miller Boulevard to Benfield Rd. All horses in the forest must have current negative Coggins Test results, proof of which is to be carried by each rider. Horses may be rented at M and H stables which is located 2 miles south of Exit 15 off Interstate 75 at 2750 Newman Drive. Also on Newman Drive is Everglades Ranch, a boarding facility. They offer daily or overnight boarding if you wish

to vacation at the Picayune Strand State Forest with your own horse. An oak shaded primitive camping area can be found near the middle of the trail.




