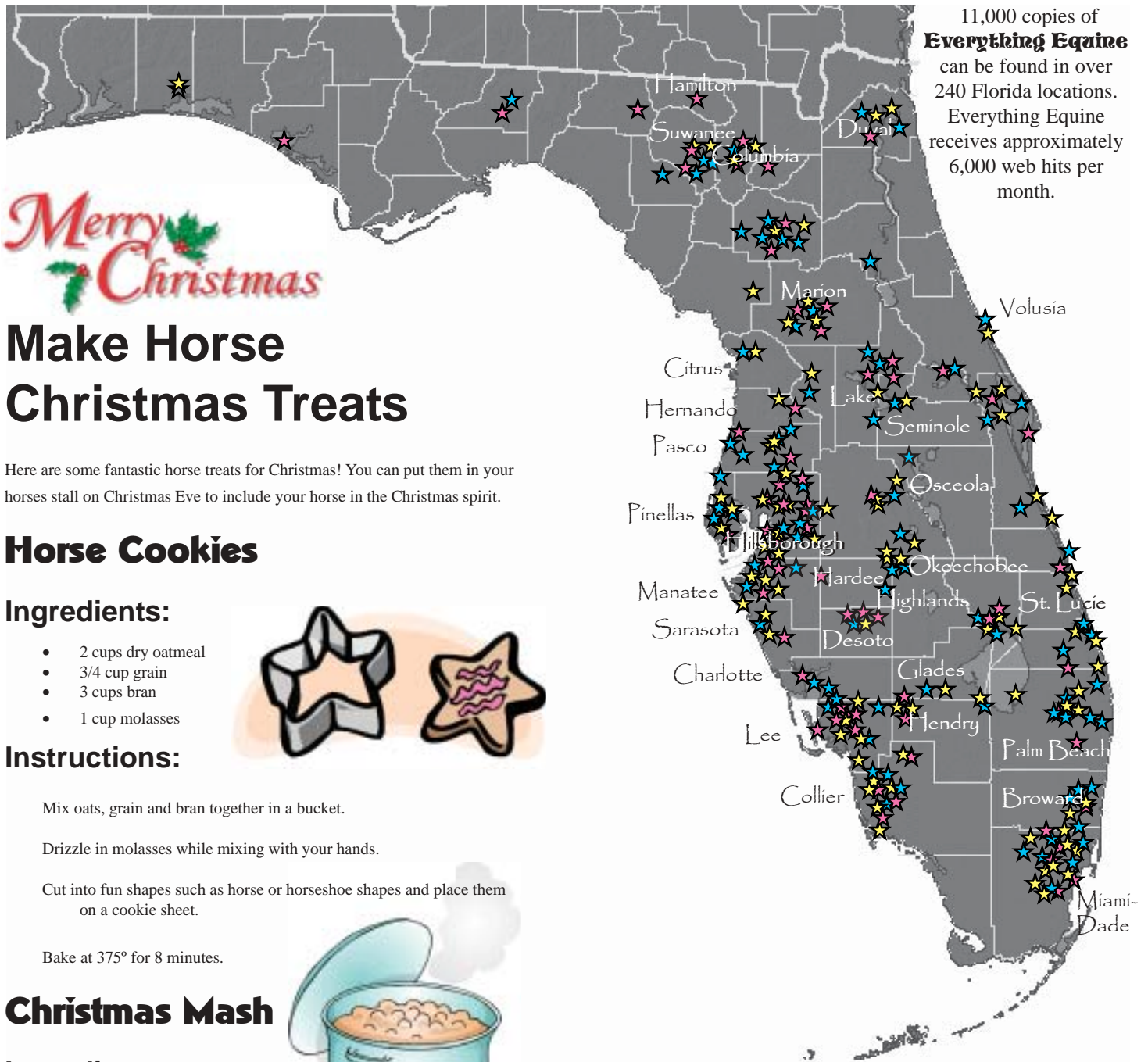

# Make Horse Christmas Treats

Here are some fantastic horse treats for Christmas! You can put them in your horses stall on Christmas Eve to include your horse in the Christmas spirit.

## Horse Cookies

### Ingredients:

- 2 cups dry oatmeal
- 3/4 cup grain
- 3 cups bran
- 1 cup molasses



### Instructions:

Mix oats, grain and bran together in a bucket.

Drizzle in molasses while mixing with your hands.

Cut into fun shapes such as horse or horseshoe shapes and place them on a cookie sheet.

Bake at 375° for 8 minutes.



## Christmas Mash

### Ingredients:

- 1 lb bran
- 1/2 cup sweet feed
- 4 packets of Maple and Brown Sugar Oatmeal
- 4 packets of Apple and Cinnamon Oatmeal
- 1/3 can of regular oatmeal (or 4 packets)
- 3 cups Kellogg's Cracklin' Oat Bran Cereal
- 1 apple
- 3 carrots
- 4 oz molasses
- Hot water

### Instructions:

Mix dry ingredients in feed bucket.

Add enough hot water to just cover the dry ingredients and let set for 12 minutes.

Add molasses and stir.

## Tips

- Use apple cider instead of water
- You can use flavored oatmeal such as maple syrup and brown sugar or apples and cinnamon.
- Don't have molasses? Mix two teaspoons of sugar for every five teaspoons of pancake syrup and stir.
- If it says to put it on cookie sheets but it seems too runny go ahead and put it in a muffin tin.
- When you sell a horse, give a bag of different treats with the horse's paper work and a list of his skills (western, jumping, bathing, clipping, etc) and his likes and dislikes. This gives the new owner some background information and some treats to get them started.
- For the holidays give your horse owning friends paper bags of horse treats. Paint or stamp the outside of the bag with horsey themes and the names of their horse(s). Then tie the bag shut with fancy ribbon. If the treats are sticky or need to be in air tight containers place them first in plastic bags and then into the paper bag.
- In some recipes you can use oatmeal in place of bran.
- Buy fun shaped cookie cutters such as horse shapes, horse shoe shapes, Christmas tree, and angel shapes for Christmas.

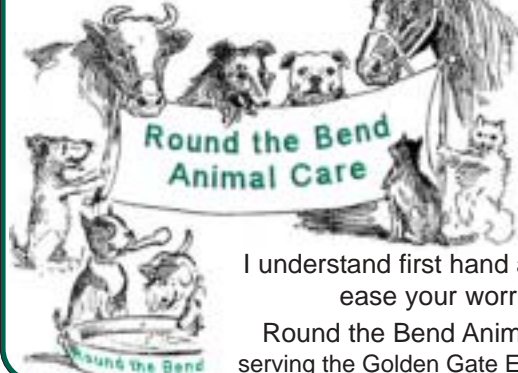

## Which is better: oats or pellets?



I am engaged in a debate over nutrition with the barn owner where I currently board. Several of the boarders, including myself, feed a pelleted feed; but the barn feeds straight oats. They have mixed some oats in with the pellets of the boarders. The barn owner insists that pellets are a low quality feed and that the ingredients used are cheap and inferior. However, my experience with my pellets has been good. The horses' manure is always full of oats or oat hulls. My feeling is why feed something they can't totally digest when science and technology has provided a better substitute? I would appreciate your opinion of commercially available pellets and their effectiveness or nutritional value.



Pelleted feeds from the major companies, especially the premium product lines, are made from good quality ingredients and are under careful quality control. They are more balanced with respect to minerals and vitamins than straight grains like oats and tend to be more digestible.

The hulls of oats tend to be indigestible, which is why you see them in the feces. There is no real problem with that. While oat kernels are a good source of energy, they do not supply the calcium and minerals needed for proper bone development of young horses. Even with abundant good quality hay, young growing horses should be on a commercial mix (pelleted or otherwise).

Pelleted feeds got a bad reputation early on when they were first introduced in the 70's because some were made from inferior ingredients. However, the reputable companies do not include substandard ingredients in their top of the line products. Pellets are more balanced, and you can easily pick a product with the nutrient profile you need (e.g. higher fat for a hard keeper, low starch and fat, high fiber for the easy keepers, etc.) without adding supplements.
