### What do you suggest for raising orphan foals?



We recently started working with orphaned foals. I'm wondering if you have any information or anything of value you might send our way to aid in this endeavor? We are working with a local vet and would appreciate any thoughts you have.



Orphaned foals are a tremendous responsibility and usually incur a large financial and emotional undertaking.

In our Young Horse Teaching and Research Program, we work with weanlings that have had the benefit of four to five months with

their mare mothers. We have reduced post-transport health problems to virtually zero by getting the foals used to us before they are weaned and giving them supplemental vitamin C (0.01 gm/kg of body weight) twice a day for 5 days after arrival. They are fed a pelleted ration formulated specifically for growth and good quality hay. These measures, other than the vitamin supplements, may not be an option with your foals.

If the foals were very young when orphaned and not able to get colostrum they will be susceptible to a wide variety of infectious diseases. Only with intensive and very expensive therapy (intravenous serum/fluids, antibiotics, etc.) will they survive, let alone thrive. Even if they do get colostrum, feeding neonates, as I'm sure you are aware, is not an easy proposition. They should get a formula designed specifically for foals at least every 2 hours during the first week (foals normally nurse 3-4 times an hour during the first week!), then at least 4 feedings a day for the next few months until they can be weaned onto a hay/pasture/ grain formulated for growth. Goat's milk can be used, and in some cases a lactating dairy goat can be kept with the foal. Train the goat to stand on a platform so the foal can more easily nurse from her. Bear in mind that the risk of disease will still be great.

You'll also have to undertake the *huge* task of socialization. Orphan foals are notorious for having behavior problems. If not kept with other mature horses, they don't learn how to behave like a horse. They will consider humans to be their herd mates and treat them accordingly: biting, kicking, pushing, etc. It takes a lot of experience and some large measure of luck to develop them into a mature horse that knows how to behave properly, both around humans and other horses. Anyone who agrees to adopt or care for orphan foals must be carefully screened to insure that they have a lot of horse experience and that they fully understand what they are getting into.







### State Forest: Trail: Distance: Directions

**Big Shoals Public Lands:** Big Shoals Horse Trail: 6 miles: From I-10, take exit #301, Go N on US-41 into White Springs. Turn right on CR-135, go 1.3 miles. Turn right on Road #1 and follow it 1.5 miles to trailhead parking.

**Blackwater River State Forest:**Coldwater Yellow Loop Trail: 8.5 miles: Located at Coldwater Recreation Area, go 5.5 miles S of Munson Crossroads on CR-191. Turn W on Hardy Rd. and follow it 5.5 miles to Coldwater Recreation Area. Coldwater Red Trail 8.7 miles Same directions as Coldwater Yellow-Orange-Yellow Loop Trail.

Cary State Forest: Red Root Trail: 8 miles: From Baldwin take US-301 N 7 miles, turn right on 1st dirt road after Bryceville Fire Department.

**Etoniah Creek State Forest**:Holloway Loop Trail: 5 miles: From Palatka take SR-100 W 10 miles to Holloway Road, turn right and follow Holloway Road N 2 miles to Fieldhouse Road. Go right on Fieldhouse Road to trailhead.

Goethe State Forest: Tidewater Yellow Trail: 15 miles: From Dunnellon take CR-40 W to CR-336 N, follow CR-336 N for 5 miles, turn R on CR-337, go .25 mile to dirt road on right and follow to trailhead. Tidewater Purple Trail 10 miles Same directions as Tidewater Yellow Trail. Black Prong Orange Trail 10 miles Located on left side of CR-337, 1 mile N of CR-326. Black Prong Blue Trail 6 miles Same directions as Black Prong Orange Trail.

**Jennings State Forest:** Evans Loop Trail: 16 miles: Take SR-21 (Blanding Blvd.) to CR-220A (Old Jennings Rd.), go W 4 miles, turn N and follow Live Oak Lane for 0.5 mile.

**Lake Talquin State Forest:** Fort Braden Trail: 11.2 miles: From Tallahassee take Capital Circle SW (SR 263) to SR-20, go W for 8 miles. Trailhead is on N side.

**Lake Wales Ridge State Forest:** Walk-in-the-Water Loop Trail: 9 miles: From US 27/SR 60 in Lake Wales, take SR-60 E 9 miles to Walk in the Water Road. Take Walk in the Water Road S for 7 miles. Trailhead is on the Right.

# **Sharing Multi-Use Trails**

### Safety and Courtesy on Mult-Use Trails

Many riders have access to the growing number of multi-use trails being established. State and provincial parks, private trails, and rail trails are ideal for horseback riding. Unfortunately, in some areas, horses are not welcome, largely due to misunder-standing between users. Courtesy and a little extra care can help leave a favorable impression of horseback riders. Here are a few ideas that can help keep all users safe and happy.

- Don't canter, lope or gallop unless you can see well ahead of you that the trail is clear of other users.
- Walk around corners, bends and across trail junctions.
- Walk single file past other trail users.
- Be aware of how repeated horse traffic can cause erosion over time. Spread out on hills instead of making a deep single track. Be aware of how hooves may damage surfaced trails. Ride slowly or move off to the side.

Always, whether on the trail or in the ring wear your helmet and safe footwear or use safety stirrups.

Ride a horse that is trail wise. Before heading out on trail make sure your horse is accustomed to pedestrians, bicycles, ATVs, dirt bikes and any other traffic you may encounter.

Take the initiative to move off the trail, especially for pedestrians. Many people are intimidated by horses.

Don't litter.

If your horse is startled by the sudden appearance of another trail user politely ask them to say hello so your horse can recognize them as another human.

Not everyone takes horse manure for granted like horse lovers do. If your horse drops manure on the trail, get off and clear it off the track. Trails in some areas have been closed to horses for fear of contamination. Once exposed to the sun, horse manure has little in it to contaminate ground water. Even if you fall face first in a fresh pile, it's unlikely you'd pick up any harmful bacterial. However, don't expect non-horse people to know that.

Clean up after your horse in the parking lot if you've trailered in. Don't leave manure, urine puddles, or old hay lying about. Bring a muck bucket and a manure fork to clean up with. Wash away urine with a few buckets of water.

Dirt bikes, ATVs and other motorized vehicles may be encountered on some multi-use trails. If you are riding in an area where you will meet these users try to stay out of their way. Better yet, try and establish an understanding between vehicle users and horseback riders so both can enjoy the trail safely. This might require a little more time on your part, but it will be worth it if unfortunate encounters or accidents can be avoided.

Always, always be polite, even if someone is impolite to you. Do everything you can to leave other users with a favorable impression of horseback riders.


