## Shine at your next show!

If your discipline calls for shiny boots, try these tips to achieve that "spit-shined" look.

1. Spread a thick layer of paste polish over the leather to be shined.

2. Allow it to dry (5-10 minutes).

3. Wrap a soft, clean cloth around your index finger so you have a smooth area (no wrinkles) on the end of your finger and dip it in water so it is wet but not dripping. The reason

to use a wet cloth is to stop the fine coats of polish sticking to the cloth and to encourage the polish to stick to the leather.

4. Using a small circular motion, buff the dried polish with the wet cloth until a shine starts to develop.

5. Then, still using the damp rag on your finger, apply a fine layer of polish in a circular motion and keep on rubbing lightly until a hazy shine develops.

6. Keeping the rag damp, KEEP applying thin layers of wax, in the same circular motion, until you have a completely smooth surface that gives the glossy shine.

If you use too much polish, the solvent in the polish you are applying will dissolve the base you have already built up and you will have to start again in that area.

7. When sufficient shine has developed, use a clean, dry, soft cloth to give it a final buff and remove any last haze.

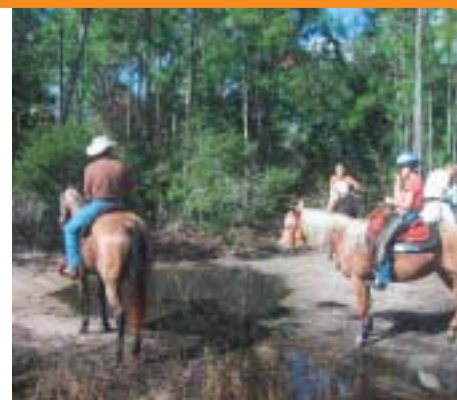


## 2nd Annual Trail Ride at Prairie Pines

Til they stacked one bale of hay at a time to put goat up on high.

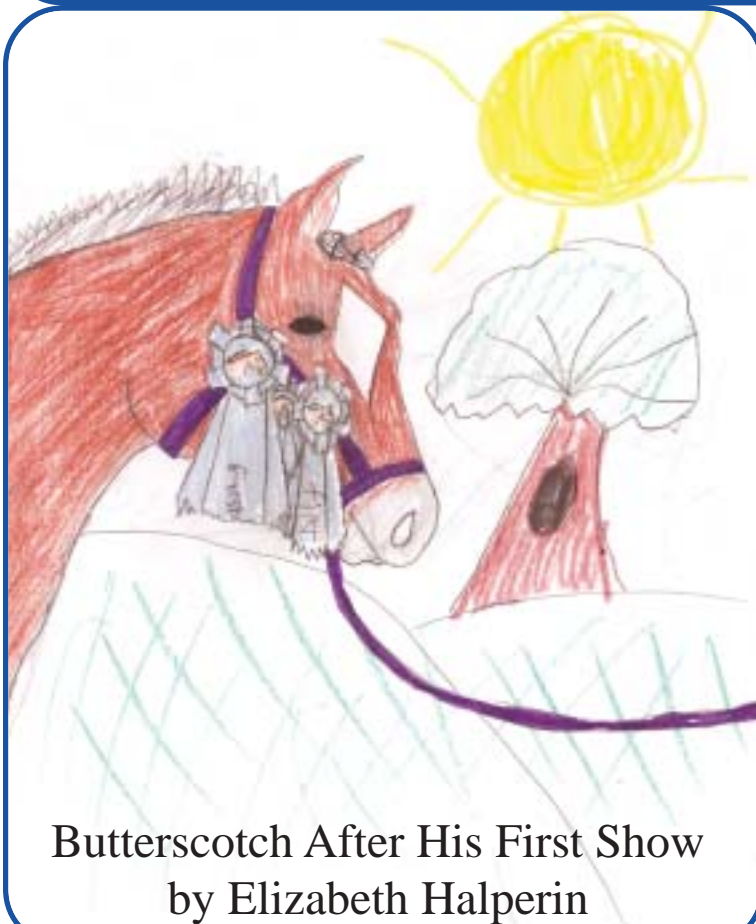
But mounting a pile of hay to the goat was hardly a test.

# Trivial Pursuit - Equestrian Edition

- Horse's hooves grow at a rate of about 1cm per month.
- The forelock on a horse's head helps to keep flies out of the eyes. 
- Horse's legs are built so that they can sleep standing up, but to get a good rest they need be to lying down.
- Each leg has a small spot that looks like a scar called a 'chestnut'.
- Horse's knee caps are not done fusing until they are about 3 1/2 years old. That's why many young racehorses are injured.
- Mares come in to heat around age 1, but usually can't be safely bred until 4.
- Stallions are mature and can breed around 2 or 3 years of age. 
- A horse's heart weighs about 10 pounds.
- A horse's back cannot bend, it remains stiff when the horse moves. That's why it's hard for horses to get up after rolling or resting.
- The teeth take up more room in a horse's head than its brain does.
- Horses can see color.
- Horses can see in two directions at once.
- Horses have two blind spots where they cannot see directly in front of them, and directly behind them.
- Human hair and fingernails are made from the same protein as horse hooves.
- Horses have 36-42 teeth, with females usually having 36 and stallions and geldings having 40-42. "Canine teeth", remains of fighting teeth, are present on some horses, usually males, in either 1 or 2 pairs. "Wolf teeth" can be present in males or females, and sometimes have to be pulled because they cause pain. 
- Most breeds of horses have 18 ribs, 6 lumbar bones, and 18 tail vertebrae. Arabians have 17 ribs, 5 lumbar bones, and 16 tail vertebrae.
- A full grown horse that weighs about 1,000 pounds contains approximately 13.2 gallons of blood.
- Horses have about 175 bones in their body.
- Horses make 8 basic sounds- snort, squeal, greeting nicker, courtship nicker, maternal nicker, neigh, roar, blow.

- It is almost impossible for a horse to vomit— if they do, their stomachs usually rupture soon after.
- It takes a horse 60 days to double it's birth weight.
- A horse focuses its eye by changing the angle of its head, not by changing the shape of the lens of the eye, as humans do.
- While horses graze, they keep a look out for predators.
- A racehorse averages a weight loss of between 15 and 25 pounds during a race.
- Adult electric eels 5 feet to 7 feet long produce enough electricity – 600 volts – to stun a horse. 
- A horse weighing around 1000 lbs. voids from 1 1/2 to 8 1/2 quarts of urine daily.
- A horse's gestation period is 11 months, but can be anywhere from 10-12 months long.

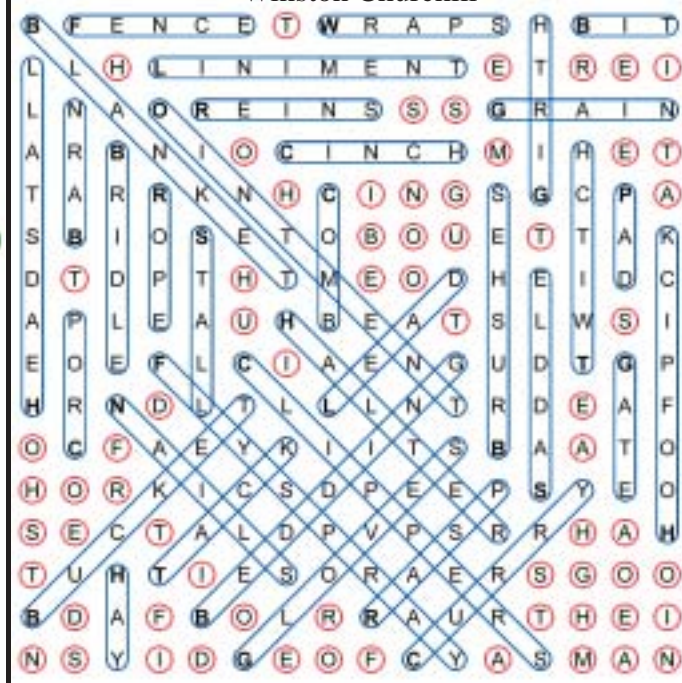

## How do I treat white spots on a horse's face?



My 3-year-old Quarter Horse developed  
"bleach spots" on her face. A friend of  
mine saw them and said that this was  
some type of mineral deficiency which is easily  
corrected with a supplement. I'd like to get the  
color back in these spots. Do you know what this  
supplement might be?



Loss of pigmentation sometimes does  
respond to supplementation with copper  
and zinc, though there are several other  
causes that are not nutritional. If your horse is on  
a good commercial concentrate and has a trace  
mineral block I would doubt if it were a copper/  
zinc deficit. Loss of pigmentation also is more  
common in Arabians than Quarter Horses. There  
is a genetic disorder in some breeds, of which the  
Quarter Horse is one, that can cause a "spidery"  
loss of pigment on the body, but that is not  
usually restricted to the face. If the horse is on  
only minimal grain and locally grown hay or  
pasture, you could try using a trace mineral  
supplement. There are lots of supplements out  
there-read the labels and pick one that would  
provide 15 to 30 mg copper and 60 to 100 mg  
zinc per day for a few weeks to see if it helps.
